WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6

Arrive in Canandaigua, New York via Rochester International Airport. Canandaigua is a short 40 minute drive from ROC. You can rent a car, hail a taxi, or notify an Uber driver for transportation options.

Welcome reception: Settle in to your comfortable suite, then join HGSA for the evening welcome reception, hosted by **Hammer Packaging** at 7:00 pm. Our conference hotel is the Inn on the Lake in Canandaigua.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 7

- Bejo Seed in Geneva. We will review all our own HGSA trials and also have the opportunity of going through all of Bejo Seed's display gardens and comparison trials. We will enjoy a progressive lunch while we wander in the Bejo Gardens. Thanks Bejo for providing such a wonderful lunch experience!
- 3. The day will continue on to the Hall area for viewing of more **HGSA member trials** at **Seneca Vegetable Research**.
- 4. On our way back to the conference hotel we will make a quick stop at one of **Wegman's** <u>https://www.wegmans.com/</u> unique grocery stores in Canandaigua.
